

APPENDIX E

CRITERIA FOR GRANTING OF A WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP TO A FLEET

The World's Championship Organising Committee of any Fleet wishing to conduct a World's Championship must provide a submission covering the following subjects. The International Governing Committee (IGC) must be satisfied with each section of the submission. Venue and dates must be published no less than eighteen months in advance of the Championship regatta.

1. VENUE

The waters on which the series is to be held should satisfy the requirements of 'Rules Governing The World's Championship and Other Sanctioned Events as Applicable', Appendix A, Rule 11.C.(2), and "Standard World's Championship Sailing Instructions", Appendix B, Rule 9.1.

2. SHORE FACILITIES.

The following facilities must be provided:

- (a) Suitable launching, docking and hauling out;
- (b) Entry registration area;
- (c) Skippers meeting area;
- (d) International Jury and Protest room;
- (e) Official Notice Board;
- (f) Signal mast;
- (g) Boat and sail measurement area; and
- (h) Trailer park and storage.

3. THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE:

- (a) shall provide an International Jury (Appendix A, Rule 5), at least one member of which is an Etchells Class member;
- (b) shall provide a Race Committee with particular attention to Appendix A, Rule 5.A. Quote: "The World's Championship Race Committee shall include at least one Etchells Class member conversant with the rules and procedures of the Class, who shall advise the Chairman on all decisions affecting the conduct of the races and shall serve as the principal liaison officer between the Race Committee and the International Jury. The Chairman selected for the World's Championship Race Committee is subject to ratification by the International Governing Committee." ;
- (c) shall be responsible for preparing and submitting to the IGC for its approval the proposed format and schedule for racing, the draft Notice of Race, the draft Sailing Instructions and the Organising Authority's plan for safety management (refer to Appendices C, D & B);
- (d) shall provide a loaner boat pool sufficient in number for all qualified overseas entrants (see Appendix F).
