The first World Championship of the Etchells 22 Class was held off Marbiehead, Massachusetts, on September 18-21, under the auspices of the Eastern Yacht Club. Chairman of the E.Y.C. Race Committee was L. Pemberton Pleasants, and Chairman of the five-man international Jury was B. Devereux Barker, iii. The series was designed for two races each on Thursday and Friday and one each on Saturday and Sunday. There was to have been one throw-out, only if all six races were completed. Good conditions favored the first two days, but the only race started on Saturday failed to finish within the 3½ hour time limit and Sunday's race was plagued with similar light winds yet they were able to finish.

Sailing with amazing consistency in the varying conditions, Randy Bartholomew was the decisive winner in the 26 boat fleet, with finishes of 2,1,2,2, and 9 for a total of 119 points. Randy sails out of Fleet #2 in Manhasset Bay, New York, and was previously National Champion of the class in 1972. In second place was Jory Hinman& Bill Kelly of Fleet #1 (WLIS) with 105 points and third place went to Peter Godfrey of Fleet #4 Marblehead with 100 points.

Although this years' regatta was plagued with "far from ideal" weather conditions, it was enlivened by the participation of Russel Slade from Australia, Peter Fairley from Scotland and Jack Outerbridge from Bermuda. They all used their own sails on chartered hulls. Slade finished a creditable thirteenth.
